

ICFAI cleans School & market,
Plants trees on Environment Day

The faculty members and staff of ICFAI University Tripura observed World Environment Day with due importance by carrying out awareness rally, cleaning garbage of Kamalghat HS School and Market and planting saplings on the Campus.

Pursuant to the theme of this year's observance "Beat Plastic Pollution", the staff, faculty members and residents of Kamalghat took out a rally on Monday to make people aware about the bad effect of plastic pollution. The rally covered the distance from University Campus to Kamalghat market via Kamalghat HS School.

En-route Kamalghat market the rally stopped at Kamalghat HS School and the staff and faculty members actively engaged them in cleaning piled up solid and periphery drains. Senior faculty members also met students during the prayer meet and urged upon them keep school premises clean and avoid use of plastic.

The awareness rally then reached Kamalghat market and took a round of each lane with an urge to each of the traders to stop use of plastic. Awareness banners were displayed at different locations of market. The staff and faculty members also staged a street corner discussion and urged upon both traders and buyers to beat plastic pollution and keep houses and public places free from pollution.

Meanwhile, the staff and faculty member today carried out a special tree plantation programme in the University Campus. They first collectively pledged for pollution free-green environment and each of them planted a sapling on the Campus.

The Ranger of Sadar Social Forestry Mr. Sanjay Majumder came forward to make the programme a success by providing 300 saplings. As a part of the observance, Mr. S Prabhu, IFS, the Director of Skill Development Department, this afternoon visited University Campus and planted a sapling.
