

Bar Council team visits ICFAI, Tripura campus

Agartala: Jan 18: A four-member team of Bar Council of India (BCI) today visited ICFAI University, Tripura campus at Kamalghat to inspect the standard of its legal education programs and other infrastructural facilities.

The inspection team, led by Advocate Apurba Kumar Sharma, a senior counsel of Gauhati High Court and Executive Council member of Bar Council of India, arrived at Agartala this morning and carried out inspection to see if BCI norms were maintained by ICFAI University, Tripura for offering different courses under Legal Education program.

Other members of the inspection team are Bhoj Chander Thakur, Prof. Munindra Kakati and Dr.

Jyoti Prasad Bora. The inspection team interacted with senior officials of the University and overseen the infrastructural facilities. The team members reportedly expressed satisfaction over the BCI guidelines being adhered to by the University.

It may be noted here that the Faculty of Law of ICFAI University had introduced 3-year LLB and 5-year BBA-LLB (Integrated) programs in 2009-10 after obtaining requisite approval of Bar Council of India. The Council had thereafter extended the recognition till 2015-16. As per the present guidelines, the Bar Council of India renews recognition of approved law colleges after satisfying over the infrastructure and standard of programs.

Apart from the above, ICFAI University Tripura and Centre for Development of Advance Computing (CDAC) would jointly organize a seminar tomorrow on "Machine Translation of Languages". The seminar will be inaugurated at Kamalghat Campus of University at 8.30 A.M. by Jaihar Debbarma, the Member of Tripura Tribal Areas Autonomous District Council. Col (Retd.) Ashit Kumar Nath, the Executive Director of CDAC and Dr. Armit Choudhuri, the regional head of CDAC will grace the seminar as key note speakers. Prof. Biplab Halder, the Pro-Vice-Chancellor of ICFAI University Tripura will preside over the inauguration of seminar.
