Objectives of the programs:


- to interact with the children, understand their needs, and gain insights into the legal aspects of child welfare and protection.

THEME OF THE AWARENESS PROGRAMME

"Reproductive Choice of Women: A Fundamental Right"

ABOUT THE TOPIC

Reproductive choice of women, as a social value, is yet a cherished legal and political goal at both National as well as International arena. *Reproductive Choice* of a woman stands upon a legal entitlement i.e. *reproductive right*. Reproductive right is a newly evolving concept struggling for independent Constitutional acknowledgment in most nations. Reproductive right owes its inception to a very wider and core celebrated feminist value i.e. *procreative liberty* of a woman. Procreative liberty, in the literal sense, is the liberty of an individual to decide freely and in a responsible manner, the realisation of his or her reproductive right. The term *liberty* counters any kind of unreasonable intervention in realisation of an individual's entitlement either by ant act of the State or by that of any third party. However, liberty does never stand unfettered; and hence liberty of an individual is subject to collective interests, social and national interests and interests of others.

Women accounts half of the population of the nation and all-round development of women stands as prime concern of the nation as long as a nation is concerned of its next generation. Wellbeing of women is not just limited to equal guarantee of entitlement to women but even more then that due to their unique contribution of the human society in context of procreation. This becomes even more significant when we consider the presence of the



element of past wrongs towards women, particularly in context of a nation with long patriarchal history. This proposition, when further added with other extrinsic hurdles, securing of gender justice more ardent. Such extrinsic element may include nations fallibility in guaranteeing basic human rights to man and women equally, presence of discriminatory elements in society like caste, creed, religion, language, birth place, lack of education, high earning differences etc. leading to a situation of double jeopardy of women. Thus, while women are already regarded as the vulnerable group by the international human right jurisprudence it becomes imperative to explore, emphasis and empower the complex women issues persistent in the society in practise.

Out of many grey areas that women have been accustomed to encounter since time immemorial i.e.procreative liberty or reproductive choice is still such a myth in absence of rigorous State regime to defend the women's right. Reproductive choice of women refers to the autonomy of women over her fertility against unwanted interference or imposition from Government or any other person. When Constitutional dogmas of gender equality and Reservation policy fails to secure equal participation and equal realisation of women's rights, it would be optimistic to presume that she is strong enough to fight for more crucial entitlement like reproductive choice wherein the men's society has a vested interest to defend. While the legal system of a nation does not revere reproductive right as a unenumerated individual fundamental right till date, it is a mere fancy that the legal system of such nation would be sensitive enough to acknowledge higher morals like women's reproductive choice with separate consideration outside the contours of right to general health and medical assistance.

Reducing women's reproductive choice and reproductive health within the generalised ambit of general health and medicine can have severe impact upon the overall realisation of the fundamental freedoms and basic human rights of women, since all human rights are interdependent and interrelated and cannot be appropriated independently. When women fail to enjoy reproductive choice, it ultimately ends up with violation of several other fundamental freedoms and human rights of women. Apart from this, failure of acknowledging women's reproductive choice has severe social impact as well. The common mass often miss-perceives women as a mere *human breeder* that ultimately corrupts the mentality of the society leading to indulgence in gender discrimination and finally ends up with *crime against women* and crime against common morality of the nation.



OBJECTIVES

- To encourage the discussion on ideologies linked with an agenda for women's emancipation and reproduction.
- To provide a special opportunity for collective learning about the reproductive issues related to women in Indian context.

Out Come:

Avogadro initially worked as a lawyer, but as he became increasingly interested of mathematics and physics, he went on to study them until he became the first university professor of physics in Italy. He became very famous from his hypothesis, in which he assumed that the equal sizes of different gases contained the same number of molecules at the same temperature. The number 6.02214076×10²³ "the Avogadro number" was chosen so that the mass of one mole of a chemical compound, in grams, is numerically equal "for all practical purposes" to the average mass of one molecule of the compound, in Dalton's. Thus, for example, one mole of water contains 6.02214076×10²³ molecules, whose total mass are about 18.015 grams, and the mean mass of one molecule of water is about 18.015 Dalton's. The mole is widely used in chemistry as a convenient way to express amounts of reactants and products of chemical reactions.
