4. To learn to express or presenting facts, data, figures or other information in writing.



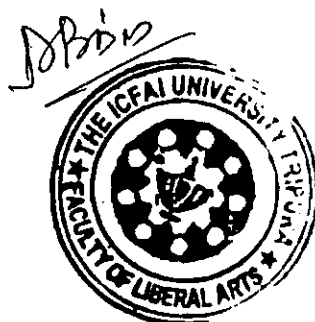

Outcome based education is targeted at achieving desirable outcomes in terms of knowledge, skills, attitudes and behaviour at the end of a program. This entails a regular methodology for ascertaining the attainment of outcomes, and benchmarking these against the program outcomes consistent with the objectives of the program.

Importance of Outcome Based Education

At present NAAC and NBA aligned its methodology with international benchmarks and started accreditation on the basis of outcomes. It believes that educational quality must be measured by outcomes rather than inputs, because inputs do not necessarily correlate with quality outcomes. Outcomes are dependent not only on inputs but also on the processes followed by an institution to convert inputs into defined outcomes.

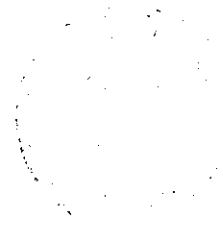
