This theater workshop will make holistic development of the personality of the students while enriching their knowledge in different techniques of Drama and theater.

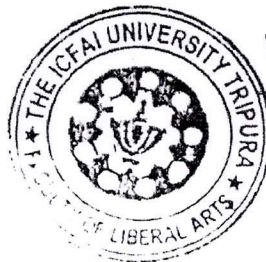
— These workshops help students to recognize the layers of meaning that exist in texts and contexts, to develop their knowledge of Dance conventions and their sense of audience.

- From this program students have acquired a consolidated idea about the fresh direction and meaning of life

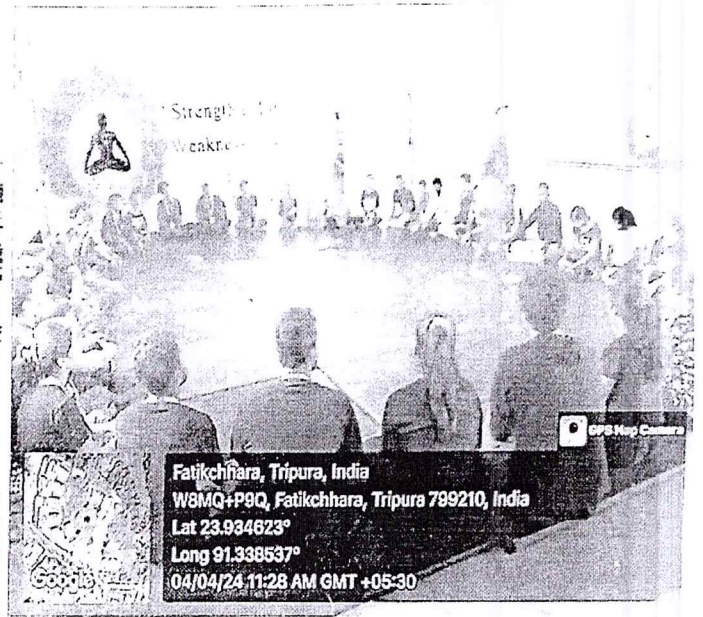

INTRODUCTION:

International Women's Day has historically borne the legacy honouring women and celebrating the power of women in the face of the gender inequality perpetuated by a patriarchal social machinery. The Centre for Studies in Sustainable Development, The ICFAI University, Tripura had therefore invited Dr. Urmi Sengupta, Assistant Professor, IUT to deliver a Special Lecture on this occasion – one that would resonate with this year's International Women's Day theme of 'Invest in women: Accelerate Progress' and explore the interconnections between the various Goals of Sustainable Development that have been highlighted by the Department of Economic and Social Affairs, United Nations in 2015.

- It created awareness about the contemporary relevance of various facets of gender equality in one's social life

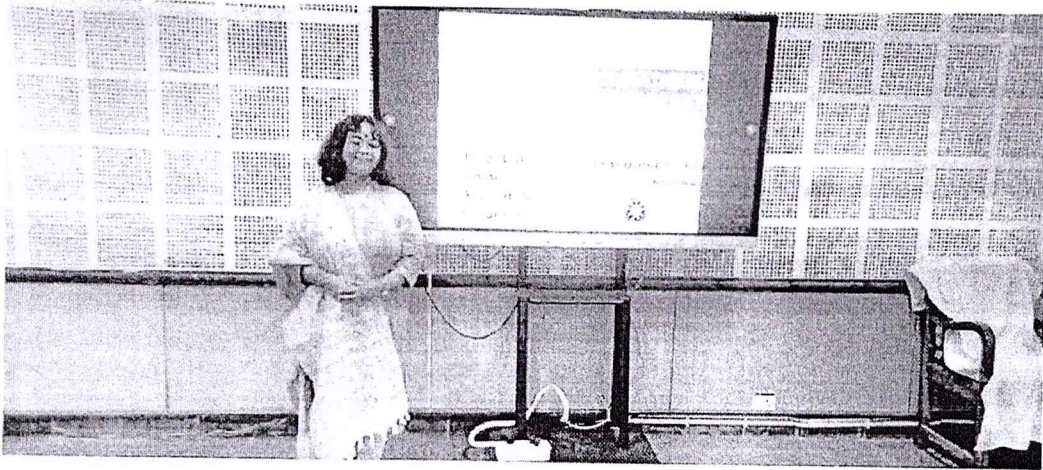

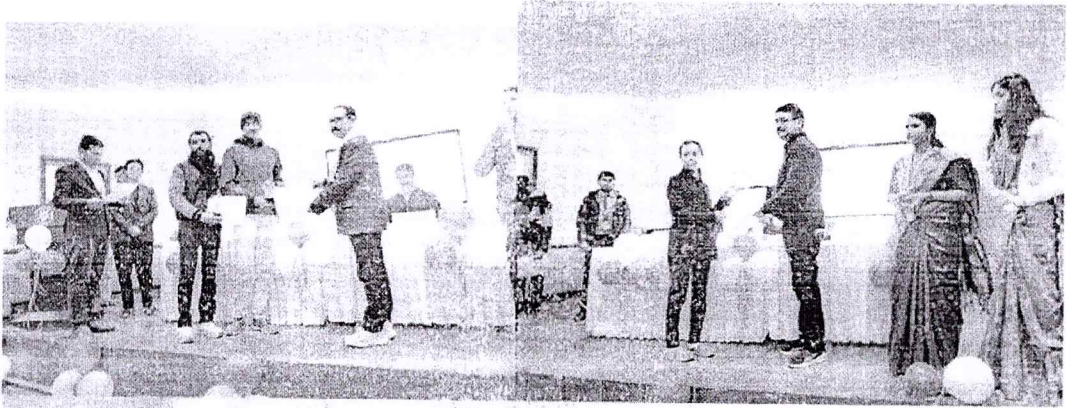
Report Of Event Organized

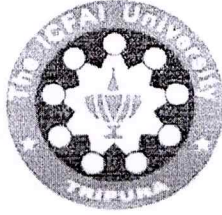

INTRODUCTION

Pi Day is celebrated on March 14th (3/14) around the world. It's a day dedicated to the mathematical constant π (pi). The symbol π represents the ratio of the circumference of a circle to its diameter, approximately equal to 3.14159. On Pi Day, math enthusiasts recite the infinite digits of π , discuss math with friends. Since then, Pi Day has become a global phenomenon, with people worldwide celebrating in their own unique ways. Remember, π is an irrational and transcendental number, meaning it continues infinitely without repetition or pattern. While we usually need only a handful of digits for everyday calculations, the challenge lies in calculating more and more digits computationally. Pi has been calculated to over 50 trillion digits beyond its decimal point!

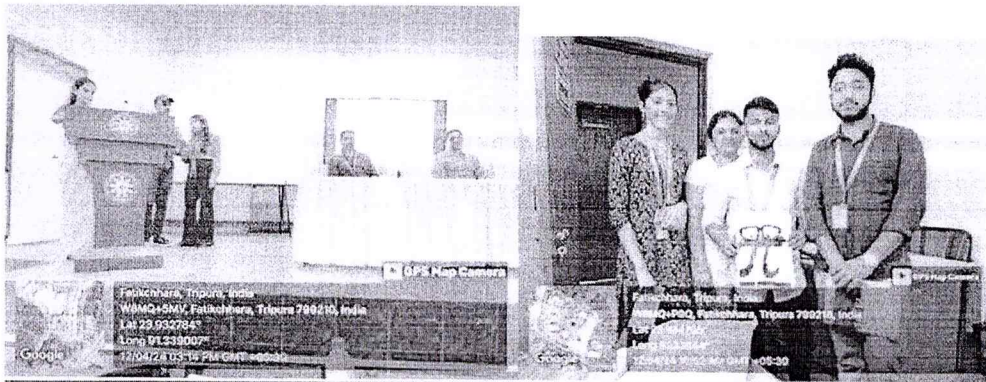
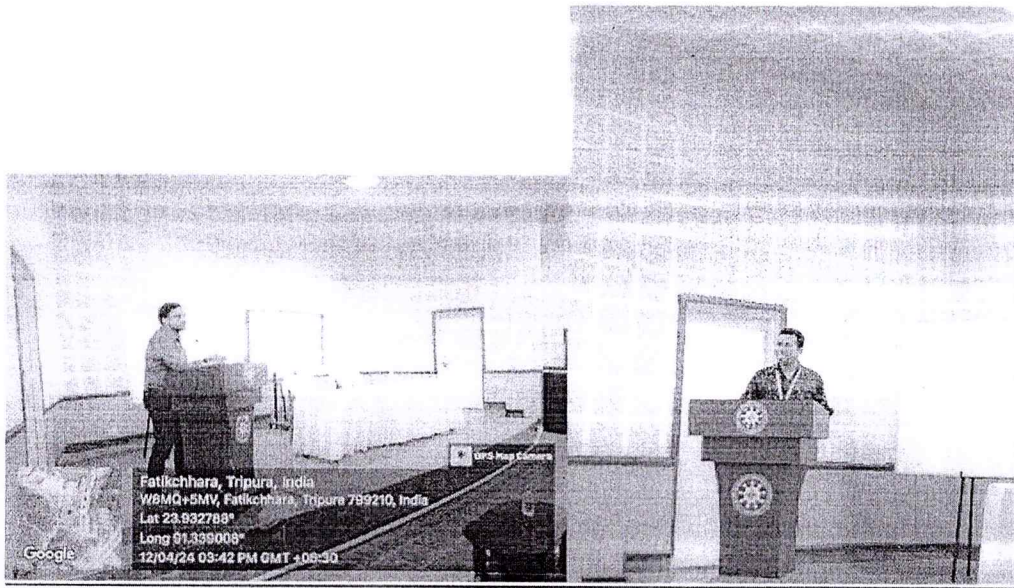
DESCRIPTION

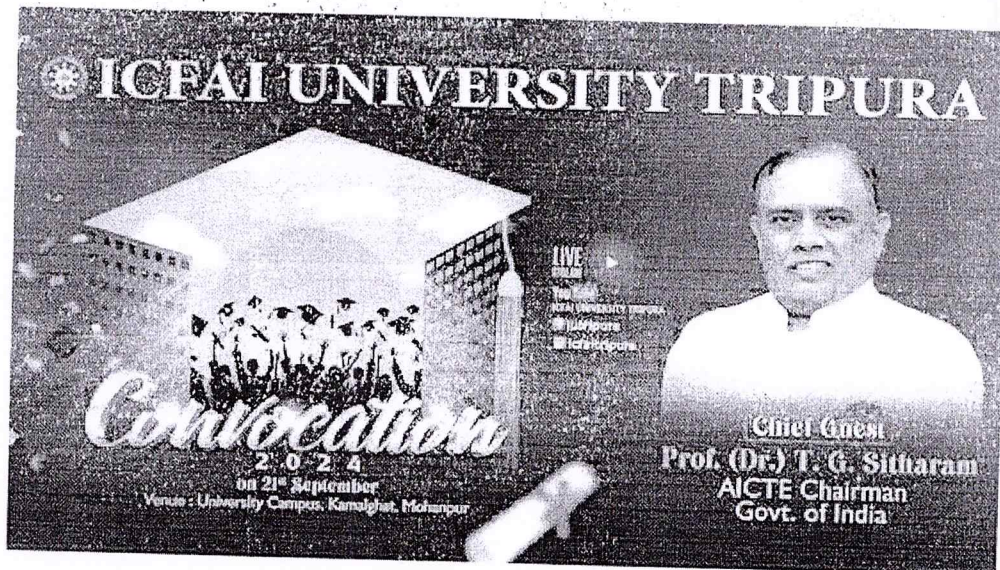


Fig. 1: ICFAI University Tripura is proud to host its 19th Convocation on 21st September, 2024.

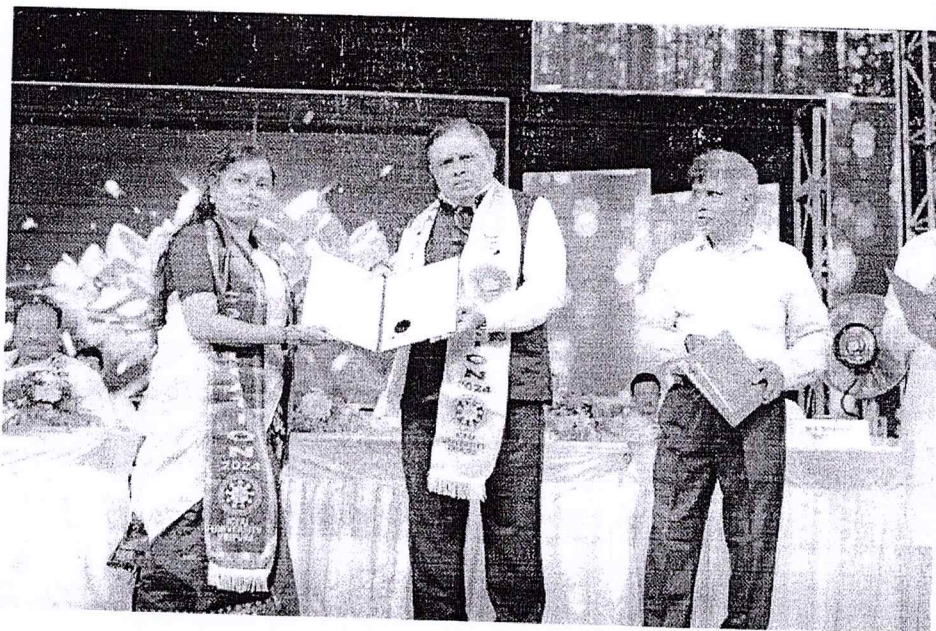


Fig. 2: The Chief Guest Prof. T. G. Sitharam, Chairman, All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) handing over Degree Certificate during Convocation of The ICFAI University, Tripura held on 21.09.2024.

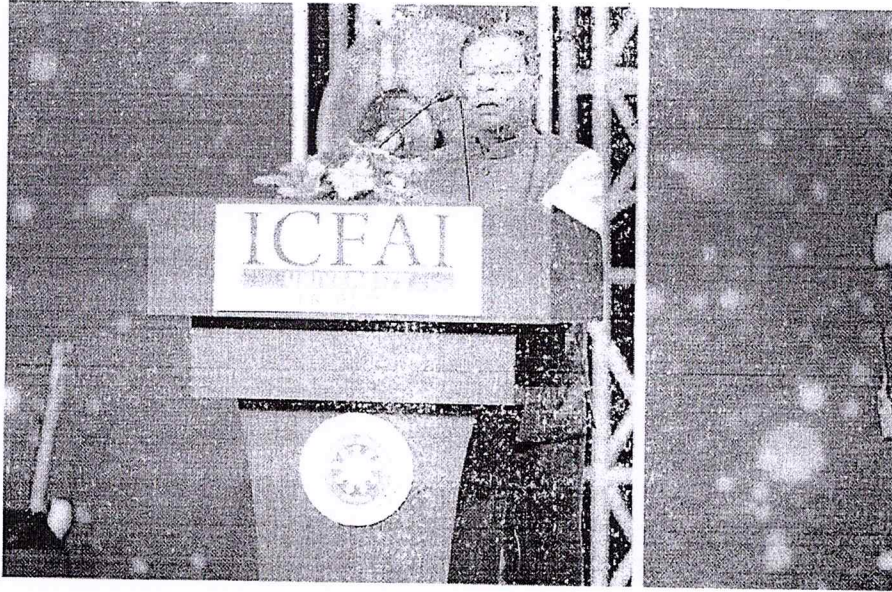


Fig. 1: Prof. (Dr.) Biplab Halder, VC, The ICFAI University, Tripura delivering speech during inauguration of Fresher's Welcome programme named as "Novatos-2K24" held on 24.09.2024.

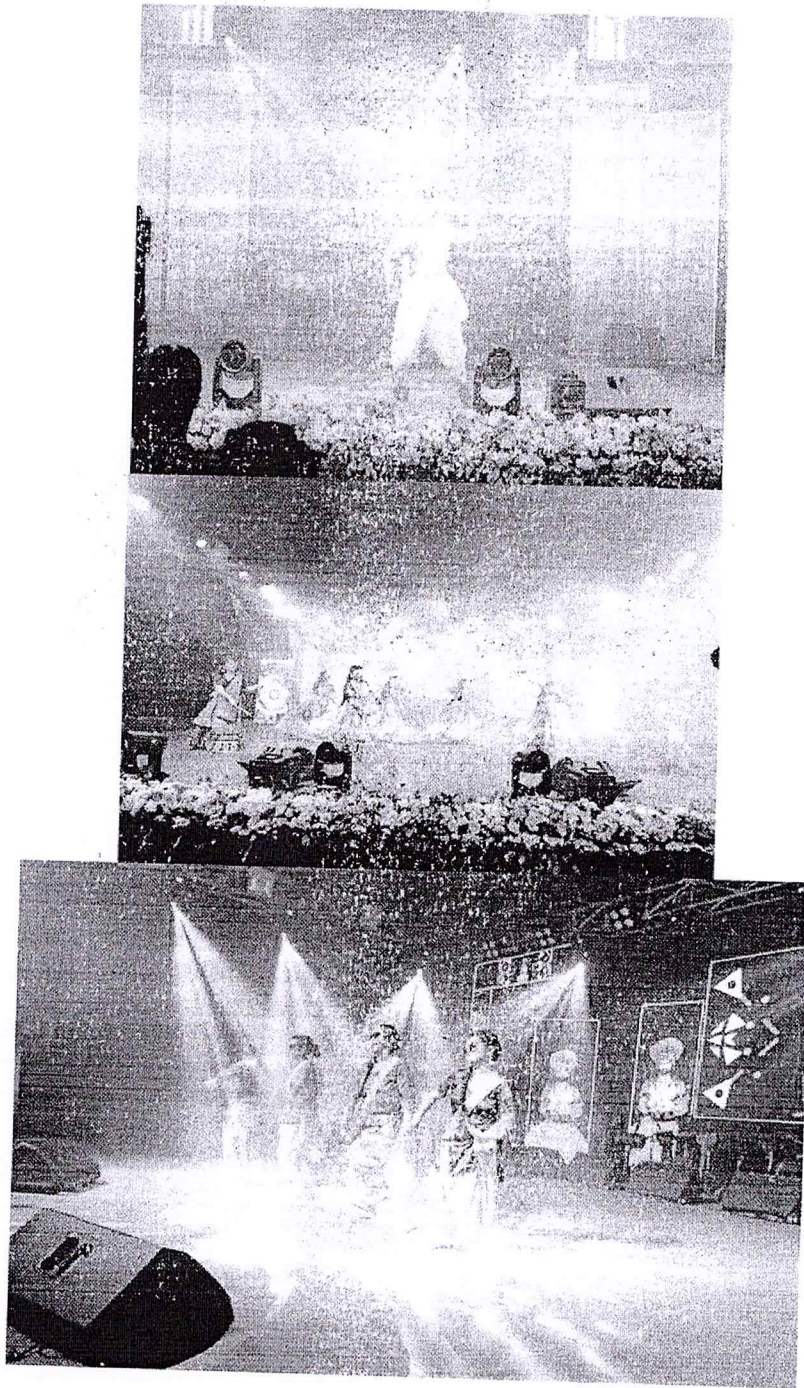


Fig. 5: A glimpse during inauguration of Fresher's Welcome programme named as "Novatos-2K24" held on 24.09.2024.

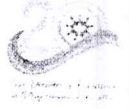
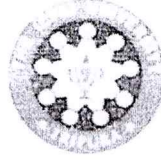
