MOOT COURT

Moot Court, or mooting, is an integral part of legal education that replicates the courtroom experience for law students. It provides a simulated platform where students can apply theoretical knowledge in a practical setting by presenting oral and written arguments on hypothetical legal issues before a panel of judges. Unlike a trial court, mooting focuses on appellate procedures where participants argue points of law rather than questions of fact. Through mooting, students learn the art of

legal research, drafting memorials, courtroom etiquette, analytical reasoning, and persuasive advocacy all of which are essential attributes of a competent legal professional.

INTRA MOOT COURT COMPETITION – 2025

The Intra Moot Court Competition 2025, organized by Faculty of Law, ICFAI University



Tripura, was a prestigious two-day event held on the 18th and 19th of September 2025. The competition witnessed enthusiastic participation from students across all batches of the Faculty of Law, reflecting their zeal for advocacy and

research.

A total of 78 teams registered for the competition. Based on the evaluation of the memorials submitted, 32 teams were shortlisted to compete in the oral rounds. The competition consisted of Preliminary Rounds (Phase I & II), Quarter-Finals, Semi-Finals, and the Final Round. The event concluded with the Valedictory Ceremony on the 19th of September 2025.

The entire event was conducted under the guidance of Faculty Convenor Dr. Raghunath Chakraborty and Joint Convenors Mr. Abhishek Debnath, Mr. Pralay Das, Mr. Tamal Debnath, and Ms. Parumita Malakar. The competition was actively supported by the Moot Court Committee and student coordinators of Faculty of Law.

BRIEF:

The 4th Intra Moot Court Competition, 2025, was a prestigious two-day event organized by the Faculty of Law, ICFAI University Tripura. The competition served as a platform for the budding legal minds of the University to showcase their advocacy skills, legal acumen, and courtroom etiquette in a simulated judicial environment.

The event witnessed enthusiastic participation from across all years of the law program, reflecting the growing interest and competitive spirit among the students of the Faculty of Law. The competition followed a well-structured format consisting of Preliminary Rounds (Phase I and II), Quarter-Finals, Semi-Finals, and the Final Round, conducted over two consecutive days.

The first day of the competition featured Preliminary Rounds Phase I and II, followed by the Quarter-Final Rounds, where the top-performing teams were selected based on their written memorials and oral submissions. The second day hosted the Semi-Finals and the Grand Final Round, where the best teams battled for the championship title through intense legal arguments and articulate presentations before a distinguished panel of judges.

The Valedictory Ceremony, held on 19th September 2025, marked the formal conclusion of the competition. The ceremony was graced by the Chief Guest Mr. I. Sudheer, Head-Legal NorthEast, ONGC and DGM, ONGC, Tripura Asset, along with the Registrar, ICFAI University Tripura, Dean of Academic Affairs, and the Principal, Faculty of Law (FOL), ICFAI University Tripura. The presence of these dignitaries added prestige and inspiration to the event.

The 4th Intra Moot Court Competition was not merely a contest of legal intellect but also a learning platform that promoted research, teamwork, and professionalism among the students. Through rigorous preparation and spirited advocacy, participants demonstrated their understanding of law, reasoning skills, and the ability to think on their feet.

The competition also reflected the faculty's commitment to fostering experiential learning and practical exposure for its students. It provided an opportunity to simulate

real courtroom proceedings, thereby bridging the gap between theoretical legal education and practical application.

Organized under the able guidance of Dr. Raghunath Chakraborty (Faculty Convener), and led by the Student Convenors and a team of dedicated volunteers from the Faculty of Law, the event was successfully executed. Their collective effort and meticulous planning ensured that the competition ran smoothly and maintained the standards of excellence that ICFAI University Tripura is known for.

The 4th Intra Moot Court Competition, 2025, was a resounding success, reaffirming the University's commitment to nurturing legal talent and promoting a culture of critical thinking, advocacy, and professionalism among its students.

DAY 1 – (18th September 2025)

The first day of the competition commenced with the Preliminary Rounds (Phase I and II), followed by the Quarter-Final Rounds. The proceedings began at 9:30 AM and continued throughout the day in multiple courtrooms across the Law School premises.

The Preliminary Rounds were conducted in two phases, evaluating the oral advocacy, legal reasoning, and composure of the participants. Based on the cumulative performance in both phases, the top 8 teams qualified for the Quarter-Finals.

The Quarter-Final Rounds were held in the afternoon session, where the qualified teams presented their arguments before a distinguished panel of judges. The participants exhibited exceptional research skills and courtroom demeanor. The judges commended their preparedness, articulation, and analytical depth.

The atmosphere on the first day was charged with intellectual enthusiasm as students engaged in intense arguments, supported by a strong sense of professionalism and discipline.

DAY 2 – (19th September 2025)

The second day of the competition began with the Semi-Final Rounds held at 10:00 AM. The top four teams competed in closely contested arguments, displaying comprehensive understanding and persuasive advocacy. The Semi-Finals concluded with two teams advancing to the Final Round.

The Final Round commenced at 2:00 PM in the presence of an esteemed bench of judges comprising senior advocates, academicians, and legal practitioners. The finalists presented their cases with precision and confidence, impressing the panel with their legal acumen and court etiquette.

The Valedictory Ceremony followed in the evening, graced by the Chief Guest along with Registrar, ICFAI University Tripura; Dean, Academic Affairs, ICFAI University Tripura; and Principal, Faculty of Law (FOL), ICFAI University Tripura, Dr. NabarunBhattacharjee, Associate Professor.

The winners and outstanding participants were felicitated with trophies, certificates, and mementoes. Team Code TC-142 emerged as the Winner of the Intra Moot Court Competition 2025. The ceremony concluded with words of encouragement from the dignitaries, emphasizing the importance of mooting as a cornerstone of legal education.
