The guests of honor were Dr. Pankaj Kumar, DPIIT, IPR Chair Professor, NLUJA, Assam, Dr. Jayanta Ghosh, Assistant Professor, WBNUJS, Kolkata, Shri. D.S. Rajganesh, Legal Advisor, PPVFRA, New Delhi, who were accompanied with special dignitaries from the Institution itself, Prof (DR.) Biplab Halder, Vice Chancellor, The ICFAI University Tripura and Dr. A Ranganath, Registrar, The ICFAI University Tripura. Also, the key members included the IPR cell of the Faculty of Law, The ICFAI University Tripura headed by Dr. Debabrata Roy, Associate Professor & Coordinator, Faculty of Law, and Dr. Raghunath Chakraborty, Assistant Professor, Faculty of Law.

The dias was then taken by Shri D.S. Rajganesh who provided the listeners with immense knowledge on plant varieties and he stretched on how even a very distinctive feature can be made to register as an IP. He also explained about the rights related in this segment to farmers, breeders, etc.

Next the words of insight were delivered by Dr. Jayanta Ghosh who talked vividly on GI tagged products like the world renowned Darjeeling Tea, the Natungram Wooden Doll, our state's very own Queen Pineapple, West Bengal's Roshogolla, etc.

He talked on how greatly this tags has contributed to the economic well being of the inventor as well as the location. In surplus he drew the attention of the students as to how and in what amount students should utilize the concepts of different IPR's so that a huge amount of economic growth can be ensured. He also added that if a product is rejected then on what grounds this is done for example the shelf life of the product if that's a food item, etc.


