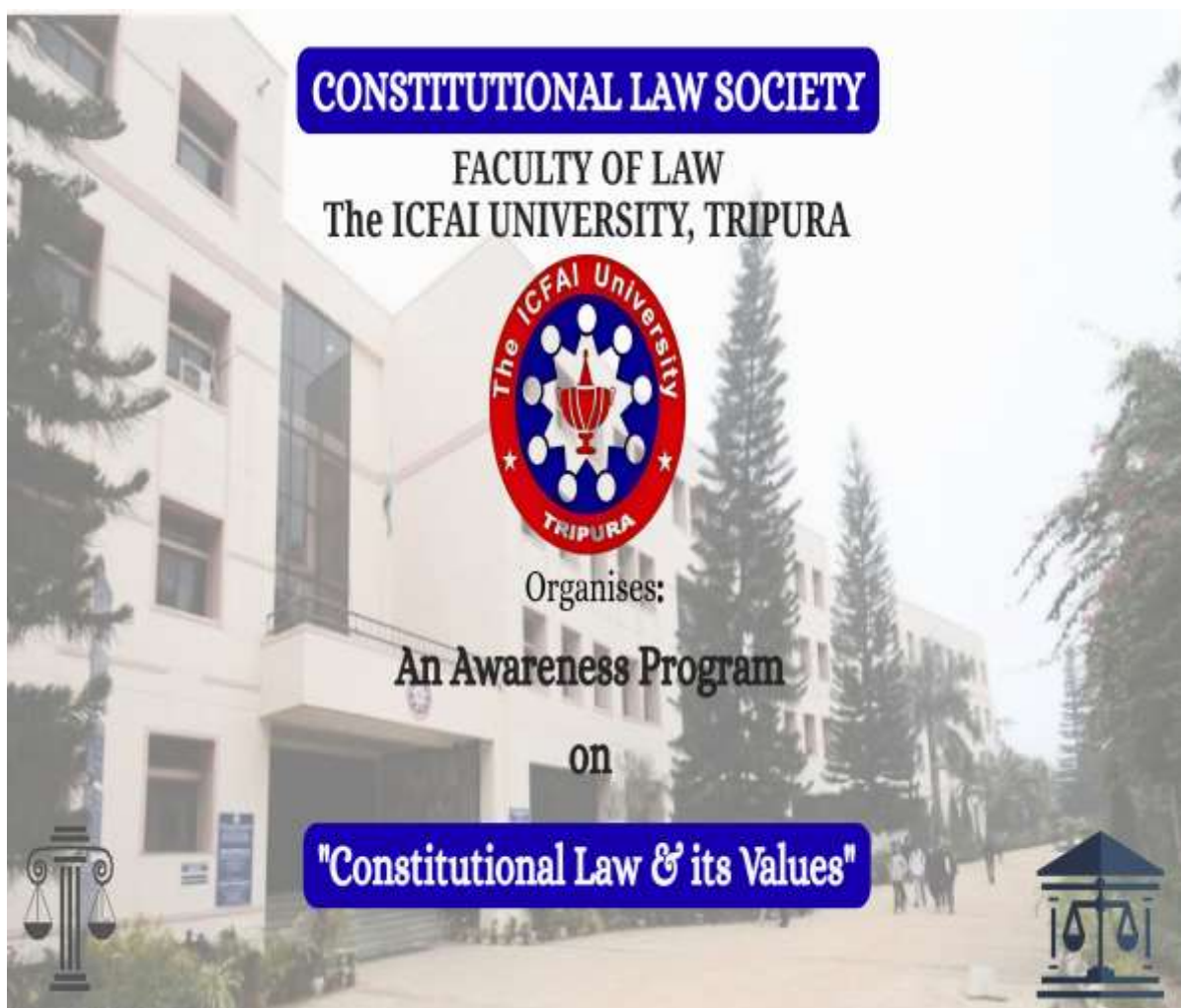


Report on Two-Day Outreach Program Organized by the Constitutional Law Society, Faculty of Law, ICFAI University Tripura
