
Report on Two-Day Outreach Program Organized by the Constitutional Law Society, Faculty of Law, ICFAI University Tripura

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Introduction

The month of November holds immense significance for the Indian Constitution, as **26th November** is celebrated across the nation as **Constitution Day** (**Samvidhan Divas**) to commemorate the adoption of the **Constitution of India**. In honor of this occasion, the **Constitutional Law Society** of the **Faculty of Law, ICFAI University Tripura**, organized a **two-day Outreach Program** at **PM Shri Kamalghat H.S. School** to promote **legal and social awareness** among school students.

The initiative sought to inculcate constitutional values, civic duties, and democratic consciousness among young learners, aligning with the vision of nurturing responsible citizens who uphold the spirit and ideals of the Indian Constitution.

Day 1: Awareness on Fundamental Rights and Duties (4th November 2025)

The first day of the program revolved around the theme "Fundamental Rights and Duties under the Constitution of India." The session was conducted under the guidance of Dr. Subholaxmi Mukherjee, Assistant Professor, Faculty of Law, and Supervisor of the Constitutional Law Society.

The event began with an **inaugural address by Dr. Debabrata Roy**, Coordinator, Faculty of Law, ICFAI University Tripura. In his insightful lecture, Dr. Roy elaborated on the various aspects of **Fundamental Rights and Duties** enshrined in the Constitution, emphasizing how these provisions form the **cornerstone of Indian democracy** and ensure **harmony**, **equality**, **and justice** within society.

Following this, three student speakers — Ms. Sayantika Das, Ms. Bidipta Dutta Choudhury, and Ms. Payel Biswas — delivered engaging and informative presentations. Their interactive sessions encouraged participation from students of Classes X to XII, who actively engaged in discussions and raised thoughtful questions on their constitutional entitlements and civic responsibilities.

Day 2: Understanding Constitutional Values and Social Issues (5th November 2025)

The second day of the outreach program, held on **5th November 2025**, focused on the theme "Constitutional Values and Contemporary Social Issues." This session aimed at sensitizing students of Classes VII to IX to the importance of constitutional morality and the role of law in addressing modern social challenges.

The event was graced by **Dr. Nabarun Bhattacharjee**, Principal, Faculty of Law, ICFAI University Tripura, along with **Dr. Subholaxmi Mukherjee** and **Dr. Rajendra Kumar**. The

speakers encouraged the young audience to imbibe **constitutional morality**, develop **legal awareness**, and act as responsible citizens in their daily lives.

Responding to the school committee's request, the second day's discussions focused on vital youth-centric social issues, including Child Marriage, Sexual Harassment, Blackmailing, and Drug Addiction.
