**Report on One-Day Online Workshop- “Click, Stream, Pay Tax? – GST & the Digital Economy through the Lens of Real Cases”**

**Program overview:**

The Corporate Law Society, Faculty of Law, ICFAI University Tripura organized a one-day online workshop titled “Click, Stream, and Pay Tax?-GST & the Digital Economy through the Lens of Real Cases” on *9 April 2026 from 3:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.* The program was conducted online through Google Meet, indicating a focused academic engagement on contemporary taxation issues arising from digital transactions and platform-based economies.

**Theme of the program:**

The central theme of the workshop was the application of Goods and Services Tax to the digital economy, framed through the topic “*Click, Stream, Pay Tax?-GST & the Digital Economy through the Lens of Real Cases.*” This theme is academically significant because it addresses the growing interaction between law, technology, e-commerce, online streaming, and digital service taxation in India.

**Schedule of proceedings:**

The program began at *3:00 p.m.* with the greeting of dignitaries and participants by *Dr. Mousumi Kalita, Assistant Professor, Faculty of Law.* This was followed by the welcome address from **Prof. (Dr.) A. Ranganath, Registrar, ICFAI University Tripura, from 3:05 p.m. to 3:10 p.m.,** and an introduction to the topic by **Dr. Raghunath Chakraborty, Assistant Professor & Convener of Corporate Law Society , Faculty of Law, from 3:10 p.m. to 3:15 p.m.**

The main deliberation session ran from *3:15 p.m. to 4:45 p.m.* and was delivered by *Prof. (Dr.) Mohd. Nizam Ashraf Khan, Professor of Law, School of Law, IILM University, Greater Noida.* A question-answer session was held from *4:45 p.m. to 4:55 p.m.,* and the formal proceedings concluded with the vote of thanks by *Dr. Debabrata Roy, Coordinator, Faculty of Law, from 4:55 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.*

The principal speaker for the workshop was **Prof. (Dr.) Mohd. Nizam Ashraf Khan, Professor of Law, School of Law, IILM University, Greater Noida.** Other important academic functionaries associated with the
