On behalf of the Organizing committee for East Zone Inter-University Volleyball Tournament (Men) 2015-16, I extend my heartiest welcome to Tripura University. The tournament will be held from 16<sup>th</sup> to 21<sup>st</sup> February 2016 at University Campus.

The fixture of the Tournament is enclosed herewith

The opening ceremony will be held on February 16<sup>th</sup> 2016 at 1.30 pm. All the teams are requested to report with their respective flags minimum one hour before the commencement of the Ceremony. Matches will be started from the noon of 16<sup>th</sup> February 2016.

The following information and instructions are furnished below for your ready reference in connection with the tournament.

1. Weather Condition:

The climatic condition of Agartala during the month of February is moderate. Therefore, Participants are advised to bring their own light blanket, light winter clothes and key etc.

2. Accommodation:

Organizing committee will provide lodging at "Shahid Bhagat Singh Yuba Awas" Khejurbagan, Agartala, about 12 km from University Campus. Accommodation to all the participating teams will be provided 24 hours before the competition and teams have to vacate within 24 hours after completion of their event. The Organizers shall provide accommodation for two (2) officials maximum per team. Officials in excess of this shall have to arrange for their own. Teams arriving early or departing latter will have to pay for their accommodation.

3. Transportation: Limited transportation will be provided to the participating teams on their arrival at Agartala to the place of accommodation on prior request. Transportation from youth's hostel to University playground will be provided to the teams as per match schedule on fixed times. Request of Transportation for personal reason will not be entertained.

4. Communication:

There are four ways to reach Agartala, the Capital of Tripura State:

- a) International passport holder can avail Kolkata-Dhaka-Agartala by Bus. It will take about 20 hrs from Kolkata to reach Agartala.
- b) Direct flights services are available from all major Cities.
- c) Train service to Agartala is currently not available. Trains are available up to Guwahati and from there up to Shilchar (Train No-55615) via Badarpur.
- d) Direct Bus service is also available For Guwahati to Agartala (around 20 hrs). Ticket will be available from ASTC, nearby Railway Station. Busses and other vehicles from Badarpur and Silchar are also available which will take about 12hrs to reach Agartala.

- **5. Food:** Food will be provided on payment basis.
- **6. Fees:** Teams are hereby instructed to pay **refundable caution money** of **Rs2000/-** (Two thousand) and the same will be refunded after getting clearance. Each participating University will have to pay a sum of **Rs 700/-** (Seven Hundred) per match towards officiating charges before the commencement of each match as per direction of Association of Indian Universities (AIII)
- 7. **Manger's Meeting:** The Managers meeting will be held in the Council Hall of Tripura University on 15<sup>th</sup> February 2016 at 05.00 P.M.
- **8. Documents:** All the team managers are requested to submit 4 (four) copies of the Eligibility Performa and Identity Card with recent photograph duly signed by the competent authority along with certificate related to age and copy of last examination appearing positively as per AIU rules without any overwriting therein.
- **9. Reporting Time:** All the teams shall have to report at the Ground minimum 30 min before the scheduled time of Play.
- 10. 'Cosco3g 700'Volley will be used as official match ball of the Tournament.
- 11. Special Instruction:

All the participant teams are requested to wear the proper shoes (without Studs/Spikes) as all matches will be played on the Acrylic Turf Surface (barefoot not allowed). Teams are requested to wear proper jersey with appropriate No. display on front and back.

12. Protest if any can be lodged to the Organizing Secretary along with a fee of Rs. 1,500/- within 1 hour after the end of the match. If the protest is not upheld the fee of Rs. 1,500/- will be forfeited.

The teams may have to play their matches continuously without any break in between, if necessary. A team may even be required to play two matches in the same day if necessary. Decision of the Referee shall be final and binding,

Organizing Committee reserves the right to alter the date, time and venues of the said Tournament, if necessary by its direction.






