

109 ICFAI pupil donate blood on Ntl. Science Day

The students, staff and faculty members have set yet another instance of social contribution by voluntarily donating blood when stock at different blood banks has considerably reduced. The University had opted to organize a blood donation camp on Wednesday to mark observance of National Science Day. The students mainly took a lead role in offering to donate blood in response to appeal of different social organization. Put together 115 staff, students and faculty members donated blood and of them 109 were students. At an average the figure does not normally cross 60 in different blood donation camps but ICFAI University Tripura has outnumbered all recent figures. Registrar In-Charge Dr. Madhavi Sharma and Coordinator of Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences Prof. Mousumi Biswas were throughout present in the camp to encourage the donors. Besides the blood donation camp, the main function was organized in the afternoon.
